

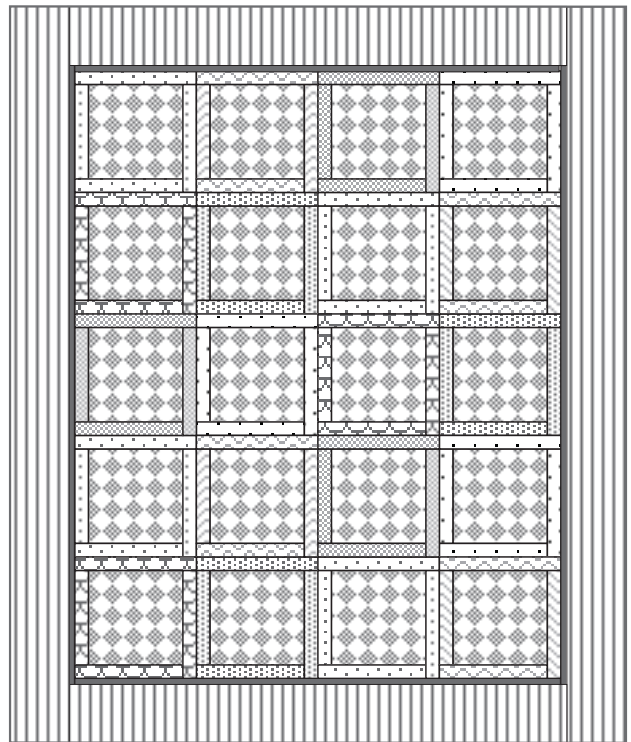

The Flower Box print from *Fleurish* designed by Valori Wells for Free Spirit is used as the focus fabric in the flower boxes. Six soft shades of solids are used to frame each of the flower boxes. The outside border uses the wildflower print from the same line. You will note to cut the top and bottom borders first so the wildflowers will appear to be "growing" and the design running up and down. The top and bottom borders are sewn on first, then the sides are sewn on.

1/4" seam allowance is included



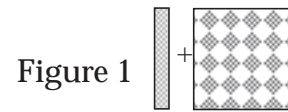
Materials Needed & Cutting Instructions: all measurements based on 42" wide strips

1 yard of the flower box fabric (D1401-032)	Cut 4 - 8" x 42" strips. From these cut 20 - 8" x 8" squares.* *Cut the squares in the middle of the dots that run in-between the flowers--and making sure there are four flowers per square.
1/4 yard each of six different solids for the flower box trim	Using two of the solids, cut 4 - 1 1/2" x 42" strips from each. Then cut 4 - 1 1/2" x 8" strips, 8 - 1 1/2" x 9" strips, and 4 - 1 1/2" x 10 strips from both of the solids. Using the remaining four solids, cut 3 - 1 1/2" x 42" strips from each. Then cut 3 - 1 1/2" x 8" strips, 6 - 1 1/2" x 9" strips, and 3 - 1 1/2" x 10" strips from each of the four solids.
1/4 yard for the first border	Cut 5 - 1" x 42" strips. From two of these cut 2 - 1" x 38 1/2" strips for the top and bottom borders.. Sew the remaining strips together into one long lengthwise strip. From these cut 2 - 1" x 49" for the side borders.
2 yards of the wildflower print (D1400-032) for the outside border *based on length-wise cutting OR 7/8 of a yard if cutting crosswise	Cut 2 - 5" x 39 1/2" strips crosswise for the top and bottom borders. Cut 2 - 5" x 58 1/2" strips lengthwise for the top and the bottom borders.. * If cutting crosswise, cut 5 - 5" x 42" strips. Sew these together into one long lengthwise strip. From this cut 2 - 5" x 39 1/2" for the top and bottom borders. Cut 2 - 5" x 58" for the side borders.
1/2 yard for binding	
3 1/2 yards for backing	
54" x 64" quilt batting	

Sewing Instructions

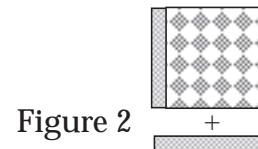
1. Starting with one 8" x 8" flower box square and one set of strips from one color solid, sew a 1 1/2" x 8" strip to the left-hand side of the block. Figure 1.

Press toward the strip.



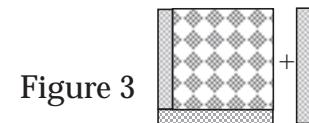
Sew a 1 1/2" x 9" strip to the bottom of the block. Figure 2.

Press toward the strip.



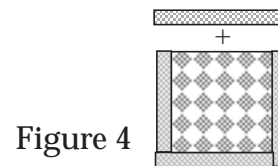
Sew a 1 1/2 x 9" strip to the right-hand side of the block. Figure 3.

Press toward the strip.



Sew a 1 1/2" x 10" strip to the top of the block. Figure 4.

Press toward the strip.



Repeat for each of the remaining 8" x 8" flower box squares.

Unfinished size of the blocks is 10" x 10."

2. Referring to the quilt illustration, arrange the finished flower box blocks in a pleasing manner into five rows of four blocks each.

Sew together into rows.

Press.

Sew the rows together.

Press.

3. Referring to the quilt diagram, sew a 1" x 38 1/2" first border strip to the top and the bottom of the quilt. Press.

Sew a 1" x 49" first border strip to the sides of the quilt. Press.

4. Sew a 5" x 39 1/2" strip of the wildflower print to the top and the bottom of the quilt.

Press.

Sew a 5" x 58" strip to each side of the quilt.

Press.

6. Layer, quilt, and finish.

We quilted around each of the flower shapes in the boxes, through the middle of the dots, and through the center of the soft solid strips framing the flower boxes.
